



Allergy Policy

At Launch Learning, the safety and wellbeing of our students is a top priority. We are a allergy-aware learning environment and take allergies very seriously.

While we are not able to guarantee a completely allergen-free space, we actively take steps to minimise the risk of exposure to allergens and to support students with allergies.

Our Approach

To help keep all students safe, Launch Learning implements the following practices:

- We work to create a plan for individual students with allergies
- Students are asked to wash or sanitise hands on arrival after eating
- Food sharing is not permitted under any circumstances
- Tables, shared resources and learning spaces are regularly cleaned
- Staff are aware of students with allergies and remain vigilant during sessions

Families' Role

We ask families to support our allergen-aware environment by:

- Ensuring children do not bring nut products to Launch Learning
- Talking with children about the importance of not sharing food
- Informing us of any allergies or medical conditions upon enrolment and whenever details change

Important Note

Despite all reasonable precautions, Launch Learning cannot guarantee a allergen-free environment. Families of children with severe allergies should carefully consider their individual needs and discuss any concerns with us directly.
